



# Energy Conservation Assistance Program

## What is it?

The Energy Conservation Assistance program is an urban cost-share program that provides financial and technical assistance to property owners implementing energy efficiency updates, installing renewable energy solutions or enhancing the resilience of structures and property to withstand the impacts of climate change.

## Who and what is eligible?

Eligible organizations must be:

- Located in **Fairfax County, VA,**
- Common-interest properties (HOAs, COAs), places of worship, nonprofit community-based organizations, and
- Able to make improvements to facilities or property owned by the organization.

Eligible projects are:

- Energy audits,
- Energy efficiency projects (ex. LED lighting, HVAC upgrades),
- Clean or renewable energy projects, or
- Resilience projects (ex. battery storage, cool roofs).

## How does it work?

1. Submit an online application. Applications are reviewed by county staff on a rolling basis.
2. Wait for approval before starting any work to implement the project. Projects that have already been completed are not eligible for reimbursement.
3. Get reimbursement grant by submitting receipts once the project is completed.

## What funding is available? \$

- 50% or up to \$5,000 for an energy audit
- 50% or up to \$10,000 for energy efficiency, solar or resilience projects
- 75% reimbursement for organizations located in equity-designated areas

*\*Qualifying applicants could submit up to 2 applications per year and receive a maximum total reimbursement of \$15,000/year. One application may include multiple projects with the exception of an energy audit. An energy audit is a separate application.*
